

# CREATING WITH TOOLLESS

## SEWING :

Place the strips of cloth along the straight or dotted lines and sew. The presser foot follows the side of the strip within the mark. The seam allowance is .75 cm.

## PATCHES:

Each patch is composed of a chimney (or central square) of 3 centimetres on a side, around which are sewn, alternately, 2 large strips one after the other and then 2 narrow strips one after the other. Or inversely 2 narrow strips and 2 large strips; these 4 strips creating one rotation.

## FIRST ROTATION OR STRAIGHT ROTATION :

Sew two large strips then two narrow strips, or inversely alternatively or vice-versa, along the straight line.

## SECOND ROTATION OR DIAGONAL ROTATION :

Sew two large strips then two narrow strips, or inversely, along the dotted line.

## NEXT ROTATIONS :

Alternate one straight rotation and one diagonal rotation until the fifth straight rotation. Finish the angles with strips sewn diagonally along the dotted lines.

The space between two identical lines (2 long straight lines , 2 long dotted lines or 2 short ones) determines the width of the strip to be used ; except on the side of the patch where long and short dotted lines alternate, thus making it possible to sew large or narrow strips, one after the other, with the help of 2 different dotted lines.

A large strip always faces a narrow one or vice-versa.

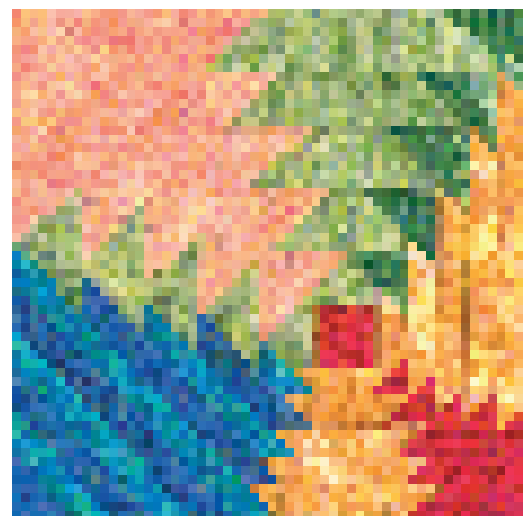
Each patch requires two sides of large strips and two sides of narrow strips.

Sewn on the diagonal side, following the long dotted lines, large strips are always opposite narrow strips on the diagonal side.

An off-centre pineapple log-cabin always requires the formation of a pair of different patches (one pair only is possible). This means :

- one of the pairs of the patch, on one of the long or short dotted diagonal lines, must include wide and narrow strips facing their opposites.
- the other patch of this pair, on the same side diagonally of the other patch, must include inversed strips: narrow or wide always face their opposites.
